Free mobile internet

The new Pocket Surfer 2 has finally brought lightning fast web on the go to the UK.

Forget rabid geeky conversations about 3G and HSDPA. Datawind has just dropped its new PocketSurfer 2, and if you want the 'net while you're down the pub or on the train, then you're going to need one of these bad boys.

Its slinky 15mm frame is dedicated solely to the interweb, but don't let that put you off.

There's a full, backlit QWERTY board and a 640x240mm screen. But it's what's inside that's really caught our eye.

The specifically designed acceleration tech gets all the info from the web address you're after from a dedicated server, compressing it and sending it back out and in good-as-gold full HTML. Best of all, it does the lot in under seven seconds.

Sounds too good to be true, right? Well, we put it up against our N95, packing 3's X-Series Gold service. By the time we'd loaded our very own site, the PocketSurfer had dealt with two news stories and found time for a quick site search too.

It's due out in August for a mere £179. But the real killer is the fact you won't have to stump a penny to use it for a year, as long as you stick within the 20 hour limit. If you go over, then it's a mere £5.99 a month.
